The paper «Poetry and music: an Experience», first published in Russian, is devoted to the description of the compositional technique used by Luciano Berio in the electroacoustic composition «Thema. Omaggio a Joyce». The composer describes in detail the stages of electroacoustic processing of the verbal text, which is the basis of this work — the initial fragment of the chapter «Sirens» from the novel by James Joyce «Ulysses».
