

The technique of parody in the «Agnus Dei cum Recordatione» of Klaus Huber 31

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The article is devoted to the composition of the Swiss composer Klaus Huber «Agnus Dei cum Recordatione». This work is an original example of a «dialogue» with the composition of the great Dutch master J. Okegem — Missa Prolationum. Based on his experience, Huber did not borrow the material himself in the form of musical citations, but, first of all, the idea of the structure, which manifests itself at different compositional levels.
